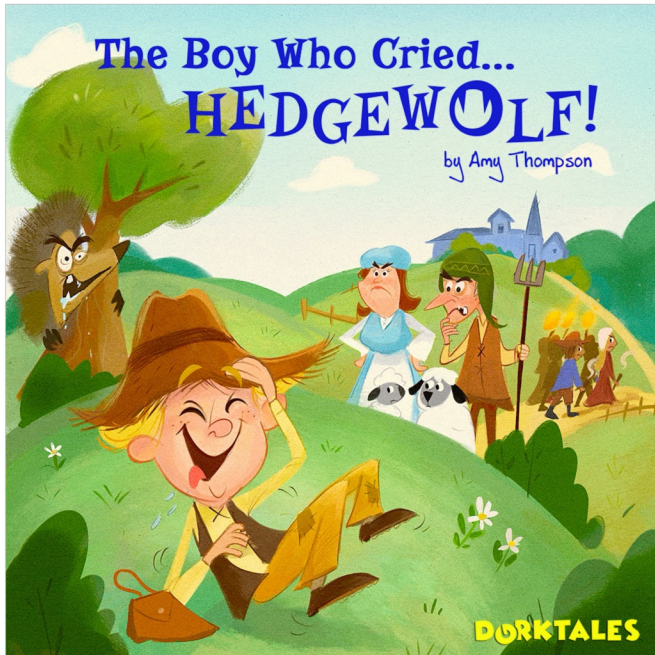


Boy Who Cried Hedgewolf Funsheet
