The questions on the next page are designed to encourage deep thinking, reflection and open-ended discussions about “Goldiquills and the Rummaging Raccoon” themes.

Self-Awareness and Empathy:

- How did Goldiquills feel when she first saw Frank Rubbish rummaging through her garbage?
- Why do you think Goldiquills reacted the way she did? Can you relate to her feelings?
- What do you think Goldiquills learned about herself and others through her encounter with Frank?

Understanding Different Perspectives:

- How did Goldiquills' perspective about Frank change throughout the story?
- Why do you think Frank was rummaging through the garbage? What might his reasons have been?
- Have you ever judged someone based on first impressions, like Goldiquills did with Frank?
- How did you feel when you learned more about that person?

Communication and Conflict Resolution:

- How did Goldiquills and Frank communicate with each other when they first met? Was their communication effective?
- What strategies did Goldiquills use to resolve the misunderstanding with Frank?
- Can you think of a time when you had a misunderstanding with someone? How did you resolve it?

Kindness and Hospitality:

- Why do you think Goldiquills decided to help Frank find his friends?
- How did Goldiquills show kindness and hospitality toward Frank throughout the story?
- What does it mean to be kind and welcoming to others, especially when they are in need?

Making Responsible Decisions:

- What responsible decisions did Goldiquills make in the story? How did these decisions impact the outcome of the situation?
- Can you think of a time when you had to make a responsible decision, like Goldiquills did?
- What did you learn from that experience?
