Understanding the Story:

- What was your favorite part of Never Never No No Land? Why?
- Why did Redge want to go to Never Never No No Land? How did he feel about his chores and responsibilities?
- What did Jonathan and Redge learn about having fun and doing chores?
- How do you think Tweeter Pan felt about living in Never Never No No Land? Would you like to be like him? Why or why not?

Making a Personal Connection:

- Have you ever felt like Redge, wanting to escape from your responsibilities? What did you do about it?
- If you could visit Never Never No No Land, what would you want to do there?
- What chores or responsibilities do you have at home or school? How do you feel about them?

Creativity and Practical Thinking:

- How can you make your chores more fun, like Jonathan and Redge did at the end of the episode?
- Can you think of a game or activity that combines fun and responsibility? How would it work?
- If you were to create your own version of Never Never No No Land, what would it be like? What activities would you include?

Character Analysis:

- Why do you think Redge admired Tweeter Pan? What qualities did he like?
- Which character do you relate to the most and why?
- How did Jonathan and Redge's views about responsibilities change by the end of the story?

Moral and Lessons:

- Do you think it's important to have a balance between work and play? Why or why not?
- What do you think is the most important lesson that Jonathan and Redge learned in this adventure?
- What do you think would happen if you never did any chores or took care of your responsibilities?
