The questions on the next page are designed to encourage deep thinking, reflection and open-ended discussions about "Operation Golden Tie" themes.

Understanding the Mission:

- How do you think the characters planned their mission? What steps did they take to make sure everything went smoothly?
- What problems did agents Jack A. Lope and Double-Oh-Quills face? How did they solve those problems?
- If you were in charge of the Operation Golden Tie mission, what would you do differently?

Teamwork and Friendly Collaboration:

- How did the Agents Jack A. Lope and Double-Oh-Quills work together to achieve their goal? What made their teamwork effective?
- Why do you think it was important for the agents to trust each other during the mission?
 How did that trust help them?
- Can you think of a time when you had to work with others to accomplish something? What did you learn from that experience?

Creative Problem-Solving and Innovative Thinking:

- What creative solutions did the agents come up with during the mission? How did these ideas help them succeed?
- If you had to design a special tool or gadget to help a mission like this, what would it be and how would it work?
- How did the agents use their imaginations to overcome obstacles? Can you think of a time when you used your imagination to solve a problem?

Acting Responsibly:

- Do you think the agents made the right decisions during their mission? Why or why not?
- What does it mean to be responsible when working on a team or project? How did the agents show responsibility for their actions?
- What would you do to make sure that your actions are fair to everyone?

Character Reflection:

- Which character did you relate to the most, and why?
- What qualities do you think made the characters successful for their part of the mission?
 How can you develop those qualities in yourself?
- If you could give advice to one of the characters, what would it be, and why?
