– CONVERSATION STARTERS –

The questions on the next page are designed to encourage deep thinking, reflection and open-ended discussions about “The Radiant Root” themes.

Problem-Solving and Creativity:

- What different ideas did Redge and Zinnia try to unearth the Radiant Root? Which idea seemed the most creative to you?
- If you were part of the story, what magical idea or tool would you try to get the Radiant Root out of the ground?
- Why do you think Zinnia's first spells didn't work? How did she adapt her approach?

Collaboration and Teamwork:

- Why do you think Redge suggested asking for help from all their friends? What difference did gathering the entire community make?
- How did the teamwork of Redge, Zinnia and all their Folktale Forest friends help bring the plan to life?
- Think of a time when you had to work with others to solve a big problem. How did everyone's unique abilities make a difference?

Understanding the Wonder of Imagination:

- What is your idea of a "feast of the imagination"? What would your favorite meal at this feast be?
- If you could create a magical plant with special abilities, what would it do, and who would you share it with?

Curiosity and Exploration:

- Redge was excited to learn something new from Zinnia about the Radiant Root. Why is curiosity important when learning new things?
- Zinnia mentioned that the leaves of quaking aspen trees shake and rattle. Have you ever seen or heard anything in nature that felt magical or mysterious to you?
- What do you think Zinnia's "Field Notes from the Folktale Forest" might look like? What would you add to your own book of field notes?

Resilience and Perseverance:

- Redge and Zinnia didn't give up, even after their first efforts didn't work. What does this teach us about perseverance?
- Can you think of a time when you didn't succeed on your first try? How did you keep going, and what helped you succeed in the end?

Applying the Lessons to Real Life:

- Redge and his friends used their strengths to help each other. What are some of your own strengths that you could use to help friends or family?
- In this episode, many different forest creatures and characters joined in for the feast. How can we celebrate and learn about each other's unique backgrounds or traditions in real life?
- Redge and Zinnia shared apple cider together as part of their adventure. What are some ways that you like to make an activity special with a friend or family member?

Character Reflection:

- What do you think makes Redge such a good friend to Zinnia and the other forest creatures?
- Zinnia tried many different things using her own skills before asking for help. Do you think asking for help was a sign of strength or weakness? Why?
- Why do you think the Radiant Root was so special to the creatures in the Folktale Forest?
