The questions on the next page are designed to encourage deep thinking, reflection and open-ended discussions about "Redge's Oopsie Daisies" themes.

Understanding Mistakes and Emotions:

- How did Redge feel after his "Salty Cookie Catastrophe" and his other blunders? Have you ever felt the same way after making a mistake?
- Why do you think it's important to admit when we've made a mistake instead of hiding it?
- Can you think of a time when a mistake made you feel embarrassed? How did you handle it?

Resilience and Perseverance:

- Redge planted Oopsie Daisies to remind himself to keep trying after making mistakes.
 What's something you do to help yourself keep going when things are hard?
- Have you ever tried something again after failing the first time? What did you do differently, and how did it feel when you finally succeeded?
- Why do you think it's important to keep learning and trying, even if it takes time?

Creativity and Problem-Solving:

- Redge turned his mistakes into a field of daisies. What's something creative you could do
 with your own mistakes to remind yourself that they're part of learning?
- If you could create a new activity like planting Oopsie Daisies to celebrate mistakes, what would it be?
- How can making mistakes sometimes lead to new and unexpected ideas or solutions?

Applying the Lessons to Real Life:

- What would you say to someone who feels nervous about trying something new because they're afraid of failing?
- How can you use Redge's Oopsie Daisies idea to help yourself or others feel better about making mistakes?
- What's one thing you could try this week that might be challenging or risky, even if you're not sure you'll succeed?

Personal Connections to the Story:

- Redge said mistakes are "opportunities in disguise." Do you agree? Can you think of a time when a mistake turned out to be a good thing?
- How does Redge's story remind you of something that's happened in your life? What lesson did you learn from it?
- If you were to share one of your mistakes with Redge, what would it be, and what advice do you think he would give you?
